## RFP #2024-12 Concrete Loading Dock

Notice: An additional question/response period will be open for the January 16th pre-bid walk-through attendees only.

Additional written inquiries will be accepted through January 16<sup>th</sup> at 5p.m. with responses sent by January 17<sup>th</sup> at 5 p.m.

Questions may also be asked at the walk-through for immediate response if available.

## **Questions and Answers:**

- 1. Q: How many inches are the bumpers/metal out from the existing concrete?
  - A: Specs for the bumpers will be provided
- 2. Q: Are the trains actively using the train tracks?
  - A Yes
- 3. Q: Are there bathrooms for use during construction phase?
  - A: Yes
- 4. Q: How many overhead doors are there?
  - A: 7
- 5. Q: How should contractors proceed if they have additional questions after the pre-bid walk through?

A: The Port will open an additional question/response period after the walk-through to attendees only. (see notice above)

- 6. Q: Will we need to coordinate with the Rail Authority for work adjacent to the tracks?
  - A: Yes
- 7. **Q:** When is the work expected to begin?
  - A: Early spring
- 8. Q: Is there a preferred method to be applied to the repairs, hand trowel or form and pour?
  - A: Whatever means and methods proposed by the bidder
- 9. Q: Is any rebar replacement expected, if yes, how do we price, partial, an allowance, 100%?
  - A: no rebar replacement is expected
- 10. Q.: Can we work In multiple areas at one time, are there any restrictions?
- A: Yes, as long as the multiple work areas are coordinated with Stevedore company and railroad to ensure operations are maintained.
- 11. Q: How many bumpers should we price for replacement?
  - A: 3 For each door. Spec for bumpers to be provided by the Port.
- 12. Q: There's a request for a bid bond 5% of the proposed bid price. What is the estimated magnitude of the construction for this project so we can provide this information to our bonding company?
  - A: The bid bond should equal 5% of the total price listed in your submitted bid.
- 13. Q: For the reference requirement, are you looking for the contracting officer's contact for the similar work that was performed in the past or are you looking for a job specific contract/past performance worksheet with the previous contract, CO, dollar value, etc.?
- A: References should be given with company name and a contact phone or email but could be included in a past performance worksheet with the work performed and dollar value. The more information given is helpful.
